

# Faulkner County Fair Parade Committee

Dear Elementary School Principals and PTO Presidents:

It's fair time and that means it's time for the Faulkner County Fair Parade. The Fair Parade will be held on Tuesday, September 19 at 5:00 p.m. in downtown Conway. ***This year's Parade theme will be "Heroes and Fairytales at the Faulkner County Fair."***

Below are a few things you should know about the float judging process.

1. Judges will have the opportunity to preview the floats 30 minutes before the parade begins. This will require floats to be in their places at **4:30 p.m.** (Faulkner St.) on the day of the parade.
2. Judges score will take into account the preliminary walk through and the appearance during the actual parade. So it's important to be there early.
3. Judges scores will be tabulated and judges will rank floats. That outcome will be presented to the Fair Parade Committee Chairperson.

Extremely large trailers should be avoided as they are hard to maneuver thru the downtown area. The maximum trailer size should be no more than 28 feet long.

For the safety of the children involved, please do not throw items from the float. Also make sure the children in your group and parents know where to pick the kids up after the parade.

The winning float will be asked to be on display at the Faulkner County Fair.
