All Horses must have a **NEGATIVE** coggins test within the last 12 months and present it on arrival at Laurel Park (a wrist band will be given) **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

- Arrival begins at 1 pm (off Robinson Street) and **NO** entrance accepted after 5 pm
- Judging begins at 4:30 pm sharp (at designated areas) and prizes awarded after parade (1st-3rd place male & female plus wagons)
- To be judged, the (1) rider/horse or wagon, needs to be clean and in either western attire (hat, belt, jeans, boots, etc..) or a costume related to the theme
- Ponying will be allowed if horses remain under control (no hand lead)
- Very important to put on a good presentation to the community: **WALK 2x2** with no gaps and respect your fellow horsemen and women
- If your horse might kick, please tie a **RED** ribbon to the tail (provided on request)
- Any horse and rider/wagon that does not stay in control will be asked to leave: including but not limited to foul language, anything faster than a canter or loping in the park or walk/trot on street, any other instruction not followed or reasonable politeness demonstrated will be asked to leave
- Law enforcement will be around for any issues not easily resolved and for everyone's safety and protection. Parade officials will be clearly marked as well as the information table to ease confusion (pavilion)
