- 1. Lambs will be inspected on the grounds. No sheep showing symptoms of disease, particularly foot rot, sore mouth, sheep pox, evidence of fungal infection, evidence of abscesses, or with draining abscesses will not be allowed to show and may be released by fair officials.
- 2. All lambs must be tagged with a scrapies tag from the herd of origin, and an 840 tag. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 3. Exhibitors Must Specify which division (Market or Crossbred) they are entering <u>AT TIME</u> <u>OF ENTRY.</u>
- **4.** ALL SHEEP must be sheared from the hock up before crossing the scales for weigh-in.
- 5. Wether Dams may be shown in the Market Lamb show following the Market Lamb show rules, but not in the Commercial Ewe show.

### Market Lamb - Division 1

Minimum Weight: 80 pounds

- **1.** Lambs will be divided into classes by weight. Number of classes will be determined by number of entries.
- 2. Animals must be nominated for the fair by August 31, 2023 with the Extension Office.
- **3.** Exhibitors may nominate 4 lambs but may only show 3.
