Breeding Meat Goats

Show 1 – Registered Boer Goats (registered with ANY Boer registry)

Show 2 – Commercial Unregistered Meat – type Goats (must be slick sheared)

- 1. Rules would be that for the Registered Boer Show. Goats will be entered in age appropriate class according to the age/sex/type (full blood or percentage) listed on their registration papers with legible tattoo that matches papers.
- 2. Goats showing in Show 1 (registered Boers) MUST be entered into appropriate age/sex class as listed on their registration papers. Exhibitors MUST have the goats they are showing registered in the youth's name that is showing it. Registration papers MUST be brought to the show and be presented when checking in the goats at check in for the show.
- **3.** Commercial goats must be under one (1) year old and not have any adult teeth– (those goats NOT registered with any registry) will be shown in Show 2 and will be WEIGHED and entered into the appropriate class.
- **4.** Breeding Does may be shown in Market Goat show following the Market Goat show rules, but not shown in the Wether Dam show.
- 5. This show is for MEAT breeds. Dairy goats will not be allowed unless they are at least 50% of a MEAT breed cross. Purebred and Grade dairy goats must enter the dairy shows.
- **6.** Youths entering goats in these shows must be a current member in good standing of Faulkner County 4-H or FFA.
- 7. There will be No Points given. All 3 Breed shows will be RIBBONS ONLY.

Mandatory exhibitors meeting Tuesday, September 19, 2023 – 9:30 am. Breeding Sheep Show Tuesday, September 19, 2023 –Following Breeding Goat Show which starts at 10 am.

- 1. Lambs will be inspected on the grounds. No sheep showing symptoms of disease, particularly foot rot, sore mouth, sheep pox, evidence of fungal infection, evidence of abscesses, or with draining abscesses will not be allowed to show and may be released by fair officials.
- **2.** All lambs must be tagged with a scrapies tag from the herd of origin. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- **<u>3.</u>** Exhibitors Must specify which Division (Market or Crossbred) they are entering <u>AT TIME</u> <u>OF ENTRY.</u>
