Dear Elementary School Principals and PTO Presidents:

It's fair time and that means it's time for the Faulkner County Fair Parade. The Fair Parade will be held on Tuesday, September 21 at 5:00 p.m. in downtown Conway. ***This year's Parade theme is "The Show Must Go On."***

Below are a few things you should know about the float judging process.

1. Judges will have the opportunity to preview the floats 30 minutes before the parade begins. This will require all floats to be in their places at **4:30 p.m.** (on Faulkner Street) on the day of the parade.
2. Judges score will take into account the preliminary walk through and the appearance during the actual parade. So it's important to be there early.
3. Judges scores will be tabulated and judges will rank floats. That outcome will be presented to the Fair Parade Committee Chairperson.

Extremely large trailers should be avoided as they are hard to maneuver thru the downtown area.

These changes were made in an effort to give the judges more time to judge the floats. Please know that the judges are hired each year from out of town in order to keep the decisions fair and unbiased.
